AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 228-93, RELATING TO
LICENSING REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSIENT MERCHANTS

WHEREAS the existing city ordinance does not clearly state a requirement for transient merchants to obtain written authorization from a property owner to use that property to conduct business; and

WHEREAS liability issues and concerns exist when transient merchants apply for licenses from the City without documented authorization from property owners; and

WHEREAS the City Council desires to supplement the Mt. Sterling Code of Ordinances by establishing a requirement to address this concern in order to protect public health, safety, and welfare.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNT STERLING, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:


1. Section 4.C. shall be amended to state: "A statement showing the kind of business proposed to be conducted, the length of time for which the applicant desires to transact such business, the location of the proposed place of business, and written authorization from the property owner or authorized representative of the property where the transient merchant will operate the business."

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication. Publication is authorized to be made in summary form as authorized in KRS 83.060 (9).
