MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD
April 16, 2025

In the month of March the City of Mount Sterling sent out ten letters to property owners offering the opportunity to have the slate sidewalks in front of the property replaced at no charge. The Public Works Director conducted a thorough inspection of all city sidewalks to assess those which posed the most immediate hazards. These ten properties were chosen because the slate possess a slip hazard (during rain, snow, and ice conditions) and because they are within five blocks of the city center (Main Street and Maysville Road intersection). Future projects will be identified in the next few years as we expand the area of inspection around the city center.
